Village of Veteran 2020 Property Tax ByLaw No. 544-20

A BYLAW TO AUTHORIZE THE RATES OF TAXATION TO BE LEVIED AGAINST ASSESSABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF VETERAN IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA FOR THE 2020 TAXATION YEAR.

WHEREAS, The Village of Veteran has prepared and adopted detailed estimates of municipal revenue and expenditures as required, at the council meeting held on May 12, 2020, and

WHEREAS, the estimated municipal expenditures and transfers set out in the budget for the Village of Veteran for 2020 total \$576,110 and

WHEREAS, the estimated municipal revenues and transfers from all sources other than taxation is estimated at \$396,110 and a minimum balance of \$180,000 is to be raised by general municipal taxation; and

WHEREAS, the council is authorized to classify assessed property, and to establish different rates of taxation in repsect to each class of property, subject to the *Municipal Government Act*, Chapter M-26, Revised Statutes of Alberta, 2000; and
