MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF VETERAN, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, HELD TUESDAY, AUGUST 27, 2013, IN THE VILLAGE OFFICE.

ORDER: Deputy Mayor Zacharias called the meeting to order at 5:45 p.m.

PRESENT: Deputy Mayor Zacharias, Councillor Allison and C.A.O. Debbie Johnstone.

Mayor Gorcak absent.

AGENDA: Councillor Allison moved to adopt the agenda as presented. CARRIED

UNANIMOUSLY.

MINUTES: Councillor Allison moved that the minutes of the regular meeting of council held on

July 30, 2013 be approved as presented/amended. CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

OLD BUSINESS: 1) Tax Recovery Properties - due to the death of the owner of the tax recovery

agreement properties, these properties will be offered in the tax sale in 2014 if payment

is not received.

BYLAWS: Review of Bylaw #507-12 & 481-06 – draft bylaws where presented for review.

NEW BUSINESS: 1) Veteran School – were wondering if the Village would donate 3 picnic tables for

school ground use.

RESOLUTION: Councillor Allison moved to donate 3 picnic tables to the Veteran School.

CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

2) Museum Roof - is leaking.

RESOLUTION: Deputy Mayor Zacharias moved to look into replacing the museum roof this year, if

possible. CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

3) Development Permit – Plan 0727686, Block 15, Lot 33.

RESOLUTION: Councillor Allison moved to tentatively approve as presented the Development

Permit Application #07-13 received from Chris & Lynsay Resch for the construction of a 11 x 16 deck. The site plan must be received, and if it is in accordance with the Land Use Bylaw and the fee is paid, the permit will be

approved. CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

4) #2 Fairway Place – the owner, Ms. Elizabeth Story advised a large rock broke her bay window. She believes the STEP students did this while cutting grass. She was

advised to get some quotes for the window.

5) ATCO Electric Franchise Fee – the fee can be increased. Our current fee is 3%.

RESOLUTION: Deputy Mayor Zacharias moved to leave the ATCO Electric Franchise fee as is, at

3%. CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

6) Canadian Badlands – Tourism Visioning Project – Revised Motion

RESOLUTION: Councillor Allison moved to rescind the Canadian Badlands Motion of July 30,

2013. CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

RESOLUTION: Deputy Mayor Zacharias moved to authorize the Village of Veteran to participate

in an application for the Collaborative Tourism Visioning and Action Plan Project: Towns of Castor and Coronation; Villages of Consort, Halkirk, and Veteran; County of Paintearth; and Special Areas 4, submitted by the Town of Castor under the Regional Collaboration component of the Regional Collaboration Program, and further, that the Village of Veteran, a participant, agrees to abide by the terms of the conditional Grant Agreement, governing the purpose and use of the grant

funds.
