an application for the Return to Rural regional framework for youth engagement, retention and attraction programs, services and activities in the SAMDA region project, submitted by the Municipal District of Acadia #34 under the Regional Collaboration Component of the Regional Collaboration Program, further, that the Village of Veteran, a participant, agrees to abide by the terms of the Conditional Grant Agreement, governing the purpose and use of the grants funds.
