ORDER: Mayor Gorcak called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

OLD BUSINESS: 1) 106 Waterloo Street – Palliser will be contacted with our concerns.

BYLAWS: None

NEW BUSINESS: 1) Arena Skating Rates – at the arena committee meeting on November 19th, it was

recommended to increase the family rate from \$50 to \$60/year.

RESOLUTION: Councillor Zacharias moved to increase the arena skating fee for a family to \$60

per year. CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

2) Equalized Assessment – increased 406,997 to 10,866,068.

3) Arena Supervisor – 2 applications were received.

RESOLUTION: Councillor Zacharias moved to offer Bertha Saunders the arena supervisor position

at a rate of pay of \$10/hour. CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

4) 2014 Interim Budget – income and expenses for each department were reviewed.

RESOLUTION: Mayor Gorcak moved that effective January 1st, 2014, water rates will increase \$2

per month for a total monthly fee of \$47 and the garbage rate will increase \$3 per month for a total monthly fee of \$19 per month. CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

The minimum monthly utility rate effective January 1st will be \$80 per month.

2014 as well as campground repairs.
