MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF VETERAN, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, HELD TUESDAY, OCTOBER 25, 2011, IN THE VILLAGE OFFICE.

ORDER: Mayor Gorcak called the meeting to order at 5:40 p.m.

PRESENT: Mayor Gorcak, Councillors Lafontaine and Allison and C.A.O. Debbie Johnstone.

AGENDA: Councillor Lafontaine moved to adopt the agenda as presented. CARRIED.

MINUTES: Councillor Lafontaine moved that the minutes of the regular meeting of council held

on October 11th and the special meeting held on October 13, 2011, be approved as

presented/amended. CARRIED.

OLD BUSINESS: 1) 306 Alberta Ave. – Special Areas was contacted about this project. Time permitting

this winter, they agreed to demolish and haul away the debris from this property.

BYLAWS: Unsightly Premises Bylaw – tabled until next meeting.

NEW BUSINESS: 1) AMSC Benefits for 2012 – more details will be looked into for the mayor and

councillor coverage and will be brought forward to the next meeting.

2) CIB Budget for 2012 – a budget was presented for council's approval. The total budget requested was \$3,500 which included bedding plants, planters, lamp replacement,

judging day expenses, new flower bed and incidentals.

\$3,000, which includes the CIB registration fee of \$250. CARRIED.

3) FCSS 2012 Funding Agreement - was presented for signature.

RESOLUTION: Councillor Allison moved to approve for signature the 2012 FCSS Funding

Agreement as presented. CARRIED.

4) **Draft Sick Leave Policy** – the draft policy was reviewed with changes made. The

revised policy will be brought to the next meeting.

5) Level II Certification – 2 day course in Calgary on March 21 and 22nd, 2012.

RESOLUTION: Councillor Allison moved to approve for Darryl Tkach to attend the Level II

Certification course in Calgary on March 21 and 22nd. CARRIED.

DELEGATION 6:00 – Shirley Kary, Debbie Crawford and Janice Liknes from the newly formed

Village of Veteran Cemetery Society joined the meeting - a budget was discussed for the new society. Their proposal included a caretaker for 3.5 months, fencing and hedge removal. Mayor Gorcak suggested larger entry and exit gates. Council will also look into a policy regarding headstones and the CAO will look into possible grant funding for the cemetery. Council also stressed that approval must be received before any alterations or changes are made to the cemetery. The use of village equipment will be discussed in the spring with the society.
